Top neighborhood issues

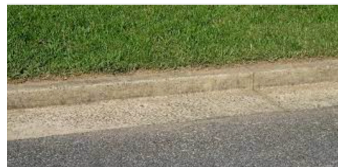
1. Leaves in yard and on curb

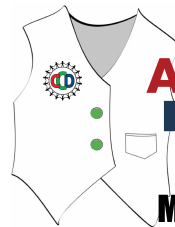

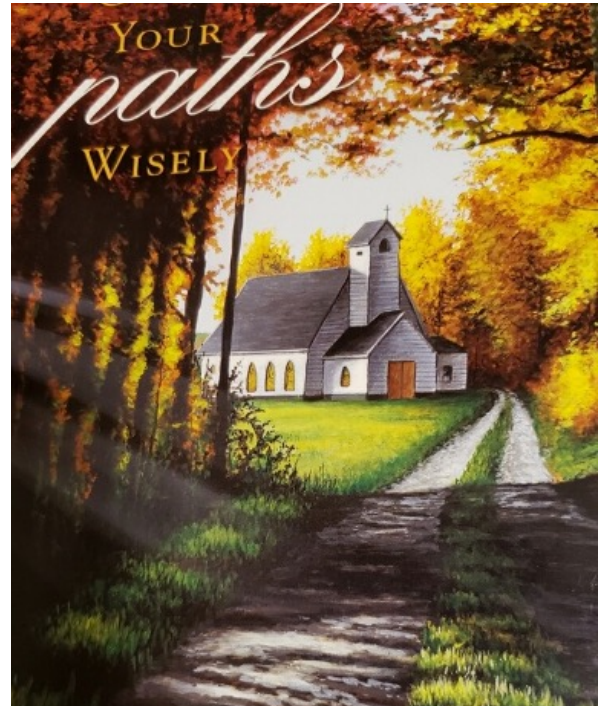
