COMPLETED

- ✓ Basketball court benches
- ✓ Bike racks (6)
- ✓ Replace men's restroom door
- ✓ Sled library
- ✓ Add "No Pet" signs – too many park visitors let their dangerous dogs run free in the park
- ✓ Add parking lot barriers to keep vehicles off grass and basketball court
- ✓ Permanent picnic tables with wheelchair seating (south shelter)
- ✓ Addressed standing water on basketball court due to frequent flooding
- ✓ South shelter: repair soffits, stain columns, paint ceiling
- ✓ Power wash, paint/stain N. Shelter
- ✓ Sow grass seeds near shelters
- ✓ Tree pruning for safety over north picnic area
- ✓ Remove trees behind pumphouse to open-up a view across the park
- ✓ Excavate tree roots, north park
- ✓ Swing seats replacement
- ✓ Playground mulch and borders to retain mulch
- ✓ Paint and remove graffiti from pumphouse
- ✓ Park bench near outdoor instruments
- ✓ Park rules signage
- ✓ Little Free Library
- ✓ Replace damaged and rusty pumphouse door
- ✓ Power wash basketball court and paint lines
- ✓ Replaced (1) rim/backboard, replaced all nets
- ✓ Removed thorny trees and grind stumps throughout park
- ✓ Cement walkway from north shelter to restrooms. Add an extended pad for park bench and wheelchair
- ✓ Exterior restroom maintenance (roof, paint)
- ✓ Rest room restoration: plumbing, wall repair, paint - make usable
- ✓ Fill dangerous holes throughout the park
- ✓ Park benches between north shelter and restroom
- ✓ Little Black Creek Cleanup
- ✓ Larger Little Black Creek hazard signs
- ✓ Boardwalk repair - several damaged planks

Long Term

- ☐ Resurface parking lots
- ☐ Fence east of basketball court to keep balls in playable area
- ☐ Restore softball field: remove tree stumps along outfield fence, repair fence, excavate trees growing through fence
